Cleaning Instruction:

What you can use:

- Soft brush or vacuum with soft-brush attachment
- Natural soap or any liquid for dish washing
- Clean slightly wet towel or natural sponge (avoid colored towels/sponges)
- Mild Water
- Moist napkins or baby wipes

Treat spills on microfiber as soon as possible.

Stain can be easily removed:

- Using and aerosol for cleaning microfiber fabric, lightly spray the stain, blot with a clean towel.
- Make a thick paste of baking soda and water, and apply to the stain. Wait a few minutes, then wipe clean.
- Using a baby wipe, gently blot the area of the stain.

Never use :

- NEVER use nail polish remover, or anything containing acetone, on your fabric furniture.
- NEVER use any product containing bleach or bleach alternative on your fabric furniture as it may cause discoloration.
- NEVER use carpet cleaning machines or attachments on your fabric furniture as it may cause the fabric to shrink or wrinkle.
- NEVER keep the hair dryer on it's hot setting
- NEVER use fabric softeners.
